1 AN ACT
2 RELATING TO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS; AMENDING SECTION 49-2203, IDAHO CODE, TO
3 REVISE THE FEE FOR AN ANNUAL VEHICLE REGISTRATION ENDORSEMENT FOR THE
4 TRANSPORTATION OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 49-2203, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 49-2203. ENDORSEMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSPORTERS OF HAZARDOUS MA-
9 TERIALS. (1) Every person, including a private carrier or a common or con-
10 tract carrier, who operates a vehicle on any highway of this state transport-
11 ing hazardous material in such quantity and under such conditions that such
12 vehicle is required to be placarded pursuant to 49 CFR part 172 or such ve-
13 hicle's cargo is regulated by 49 CFR part 171 or is required to meet the man-
14 ifest requirements as set forth under the rules of the department of envi-
15 ronmental quality, shall first procure from the department an annual vehicle
16 registration endorsement. This registration endorsement shall be available
17 for examination, unless procured via the state web portal, and shall be dis-
18 played in accordance with rules adopted by the department. The provisions of
19 this section shall not apply to vehicles owned by any city, county, state or
20 federal governmental department or agency or special purpose district cre-
21 ated pursuant to law.

22 (2) The fee for an annual vehicle registration endorsement for
23 the transportation of hazardous materials shall be ~~ten~~ fifteen dollars
24 (\$105.00). Any carrier required to pay the fee assessed pursuant to this
25 section is authorized to pass along such fee to the shipping party. Vendors
26 selling endorsements on behalf of the board shall be reimbursed at the rate
27 of forty cents (40¢) per endorsement. No portion of the annual endorsement
28 fee shall be prorated, reduced or transferred to another vehicle.

29 (3) The operation of a vehicle, which is subject to the endorsement re-
30 quirements of this section, in a negligent manner is a violation of the pro-
31 visions of this chapter.
