STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS27915 / H0606

This is the FY 2021 original appropriation bill for the Idaho State Lottery. It appropriates a total of \$6,299,800 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 45.00.

For benefit costs, the bill maintains the current appropriated amount for health insurance at \$11,650 per eligible FTP and temporarily removes funding for the employer's sick leave contribution rate. Funding for replacement items includes \$75,200 for computers and IT equipment. The bill also provides funding for the equivalent of a 2% change in employee compensation for permanent state employees, with an additional 2% increase for those in the 20 job classifications most in need of equity adjustments.

The bill funds two line items, which provide \$17,400 for two staff salary increases; and \$75,700 for increased shipping and equipment costs. Also included are adjustments to pay the Office of Information Technology Services for security software and data center office space located at the Chinden Campus.
