Chairman Anderst introduced the page, **Kaela Davis**.
MOTION: **Rep. Smith** made a motion to approve the minutes from February 13th, 2020 as written. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
RS 27747: **Rep. Furniss** presented **RS 27747**, relating to insurance. He stated the proposed legislation would provide clarity to customers buying indexed annuities by requiring a disclosure sheet at the time of sale and delivery of the product.
MOTION: **Rep. Smith** made a motion to introduce **RS 27747**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
RS 27752: **Rep. Zito** presented **RS 27752**, proposed legislation that would remove the requirement of a license/permit to purchase certain cold-blooded animals, amending current Idaho Code.
MOTION: **Rep. Monks** made a motion to introduce **RS 27752**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
RS 27755: **Rep. Wood** presented **RS 27755**, proposed legislation that would clarify the intent of the original bill: an individual who kills a single trophy animal valued over \$1,000 would be in violation of the law and charged with a felony.
MOTION: **Rep. McCrostie** made a motion to introduce **RS 27755**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
RS 27704: **Rep. Moon** presented **RS 27704**, proposed legislation to memorialize and recognize 160 years of the mining industry in the State of Idaho. She stated that it would also support federal agencies in their effort to modernize policies to encourage multiple uses on public lands.
MOTION: **Rep. Moyle** made a motion to introduce **RS 27704**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
RS 27767: **Rep. Ellis** presented **RS 27767**, proposed legislation to ensure architects, engineers, and contractors who volunteer during a time of emergency and disaster are given limited liability for their volunteer services.

RS 27770: **Rep. Moyle** presented **RS 27770**, relating to permit requirements for hunting stocked upland game birds. He stated that the proposed legislation would remove Wildlife Management Areas (WMA) from the name of the permit and expand the permit's applicability to hunt stocked pheasants on approved lands as outlined by the Department of Fish and Game.

MOTION: **Rep. Monks** made a motion to introduce **RS 27770**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 27771: **Rep. Moyle** presented **RS 27771**, proposed legislation that would limit the amount of permits to harvest Tundra Swans in the State of Idaho.

MOTION: **Rep. Monks** made a motion to introduce **RS 27771**. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Smith** requested she be recorded as voting **NAY**.

RS 27380: **Rep. Crane** presented **RS 27380**, proposed legislation that would impose a financial penalty for patronizing a prostitute. Upon presenting **RS 27380**, Rep. Crane stated that amendments needed to be made in the legislation.

In response to Committee questions, **Rep. Crane** stated that the flow of funds would remain the same.

MOTION: **Rep. Moyle** made a motion to introduce **RS 27380** with the following changes: strike the word "any" on Line 21 and strikeout subsequent Lines 22, 23, and 24. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 27687C1: **Benjamin Davenport**, Executive Director, Idaho Mining Association, presented **RS 27687C1**, proposed legislation intended to help solve existing issues with mineral leases, provide needed updates to encourage investments and returns on state endowments, and provide regulatory certainty. Mr. Davenport indicated that an amendment to the legislation needed to be made.

MOTION: **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 27687C1** with the following change: on Page 3, Line 4, change the word "and" to "or." **Motion carried by voice vote.**

MOTION: **Rep. Monks** made a motion to approve the minutes from February 19th, 2020 with a change on **RS 27755**, the dollar value of \$100,000 needed to be changed to \$1,000; approve the minutes from February 21st, 2020 with one change on the motion to introduce **RS 27380**, **Rep. Monks** needed to be changed to **Rep. Moyle**; and approve the minutes from February 26th, 2020 as written. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 27856: **Rep. Chaney** presented **RS 27856**, proposed legislation that would define the term "willful or reckless misconduct." Rep. Chaney stated that **RS 27856** is intended to replace **H 428**.

MOTION: **Rep. Moyle** made a motion to introduce **RS 27856**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 27859: **Rep. Chaney** presented **RS 27859**, proposed legislation that would create a cap for non-economic damages, amending current Idaho Code. He stated that **RS 27859** is intended to replace **H 430**.

MOTION: **Rep. Moyle** made a motion to introduce **RS 27859**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 27858C1: **Rep. Chaney**, in place of **Rep. Crane**, presented **RS 27858C1**, proposed legislation that would impose a financial penalty for patronizing a prostitute. Rep. Chaney stated the original legislation was moved to be introduced by the Committee with Rep. Crane's requested amendments; however, LSO removed more lines than what was requested and so the legislation had to be rewritten.

MOTION: **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 27858C1**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 27876: **Rep. Boyle** presented **RS 27876**, a proposed joint memorial that would support updates to rules for the National Environmental Policy Act, (NEPA), which hadn't been updated in 40 years.

MOTION: **Rep. Moyle** made a motion to introduce **RS 27876**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 27823C1: **Anthony Polidori**, Department of Finance, presented **RS 27823C1**, proposed legislation regarding the Licensing Reduction Act. Mr. Polidori said that the legislation's intention is to replace **H 400** and would remove presumptive language that would allow an administrator to seek a cease and desist order or civil action against a party if the administrator claimed it was with reasonable cause.

MOTION: **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 27823C1**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 27899: **Rep. Bedke**, Speaker of the House, presented **RS 27899**, proposed legislation regarding stockwater rights in Idaho. Rep. Bedke stated that the legislation would allow for a process of forfeiture if the water isn't used for beneficial use within 5 years by the stockwater rights owner.

MOTION: **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 27899**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

Chairman Anderst called the meeting to order at 12:31 p.m.
- RS 27913:** **Rep. Monks** presented **RS 27913**, proposed legislation regarding the sales and/or use taxes for road materials. Rep. Monks stated the proposed legislation would provide a rebate system for transportation if the taxes are paid by a government entity and also ensure that monies designated for transportation is only used for transportation.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 27913. Motion carried by voice vote.**
- RS 27923:** **Rep. Dixon** presented **RS 27923**, proposed legislation regarding House Rules 45 and 76. Rep. Dixon stated the proposed legislation would give the Ethics Committee responsibilities of reviewing House policy and rules during the Interim, and operate similarly to the Legislative Council.
- In response to a Committee question, **Rep. Dixon** explained the Ethics Committee would report to the House for approval at the beginning of each term.
- Rep. Rubel** pointed out language in **RS 27923** was struck out, eliminating the requirement that a Ethics Committee member serve at least one term and asked for clarification. **Rep. Dixon** stated that it was a mistake the selection process language was removed. Rep. Rubel made a suggestion to amend **RS 27923** while present in the Committee. **Rep. McCrostie** stated he didn't see the language for the provision of the alternates in the legislation, and Rep. Dixon made suggestions on how to correct it. **Rep. Rubel** clarified that language for the provision of the alternates was located on Page 4, Line 42.
- Rep. Moyle** stated it was unnecessary to discuss changes to **RS 27923**, and once the legislation was introduced, the intended Germane Committee could suggest changes.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Moyle** made a motion to introduce **RS 27923. Motion carried by voice vote.**
- RS 27930:** **Rep. Monks** presented **RS 27930**, proposed legislation regarding House Rules 20, 49, and 69. Rep. Monks stated the proposed legislation would clarify current procedures and membership of the Chief Clerk by moving certain language. He also said Rule 69 would specify that the Speaker of the House is the presiding officer of the House of Representatives and the processes in the event of absence or death of the Speaker.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 27930. Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 27932: **Rep. Scott** presented **RS 27932**, proposed legislation that would allow conditions for petitions to be granted to individuals who no longer want to participate in a water and sewer taxing district.
