### H.R. 1319 - ARP Act, Title IX

## Title IX, Section 9901(b)(2). Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund

Four categories of use outlined in Section 9901

- o Response to COVID-19 including economic assistance, small business, industry, and public health care
- o Premium pay increase for essential workers
- o Government services to make up for lost revenue
- o Investments in water, sewer, and broadband

\$20 billion specifically set aside for tribal governments

### H.R. 1319 - ARP Act, Title IX

Title IX, Section 9901(b)(2). Capital Projects Fund

For critical capital projects directly enabling work, education, and health monitoring

\$100 million specifically set aside for tribal governments

Title IX, Section 9901(b)(2). Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund

For governmental purposes, excepting lobbying

\$2 billion specifically set aside for tribal governments and eligible revenue sharing counties

### H.R. 1319 - ARP Act, Title XI

### Title XI, Section 11001. Indian Health Services

\$6.1 billion for health services through the Secretary of Health & Human Services

### Title XI, Section 11002. Bureau of Indian Affairs

\$900 million for housing improvements, government public safety services (i.e. public safety, social services, child welfare, judiciary), potable water, administrative services

# Title XI, Section 11003. Housing Assistance and Supportive Services Program for Native Americans

\$750 million for Housing Block Grants (NAHASDA), Indian Community Development Block Grants, technical assistance, and administrative costs

### H.R. 1319 - ARP Act, Title XI

- Title XI, Section 11004. Language Preservation \$20 million for language preservation grants
- Title XI, Section 11005. Bureau of Indian Education (BIE) \$850 million for BIE-funded schools and tribal colleges/universities through the Department of the Interior
- Title XI, Section 11006. American Indian...Education \$190 million for tribal education agencies and eligible grant entities through the Department of Education
