3	NEW CHAPTER 97, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS REGARDING
4	CERTAIN COVID-19-RELATED FUNDING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
5	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW CHAPTER}}$, to be known and designated as Chapter 97, Title 67, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

CHAPTER 97 COVID-19-RELATED FUNDING

67-9701. COVID-19-RELATED FUNDING. The state of Idaho finds that certain relief should be provided to the citizens of the state through use of COVID-19-related funding received from the federal government. Specifically, COVID-19-related funding, to the extent available, shall be used for the following:

- (1) Reimbursing employers for wages paid to workers for time off work:
- (a) For the purpose of receiving, and assisting family members to receive, vaccinations;
- (b) To recover from any adverse reaction to the COVID-19 vaccine; and
- (c) To care for family members having adverse reactions to the COVID-19 vaccine;
- (2) Rapid COVID-19 testing for citizens of the state, including school personnel and students;
- (3) Compensation for those off work due to exposure to COVID-19 or contracting COVID-19;
 - (4) Mobile vaccination clinics and in-home vaccinations for COVID-19;
- (5) Enhanced multilingual capabilities for COVID-19 vaccination information and administration;
- (6) A sick leave bank for all public employees, including school personnel;
 - (7) Onetime bonus payments to essential workers; and
- (8) A COVID-19 vaccine injury compensation program to be used for the recovery of damages to be determined by department of insurance rules with due regard for similar compensable injuries as evaluated under the worker's compensation program for those injured by a COVID-19 vaccine but unable to bring suit against any pharmaceutical company.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
