Idaho Wine - 150 Years in the Making

- **1864**: First grapes planted in Lewiston
- **1919 1933**: Prohibition
- 1971: Wine Act Passed & Signed Into Law
- **1984**: Idaho Wine Commission is formed
- **2002:** 11 wineries in Idaho
- **2007**: Snake River Valley is Idaho's first approved American Viticulture Area






Idaho Wine - 150 Years in the Making

- **2008**: \$73 million dollar Economic Impact
- **2010**: 43 wineries and 1,200 acres planted
- **2013**: 50 wineries, \$169.3 million dollar Economic Impact
- **2015**: Eagle Foothills American Viticultural Area (AVA) approved
- **2016**: Lewis-Clark Valley American Viticultural Area (AVA) approved
- **2017**: \$209.9 million dollar Economic Impact
- **2020**: 65 wineries and 1,300 acres planted
