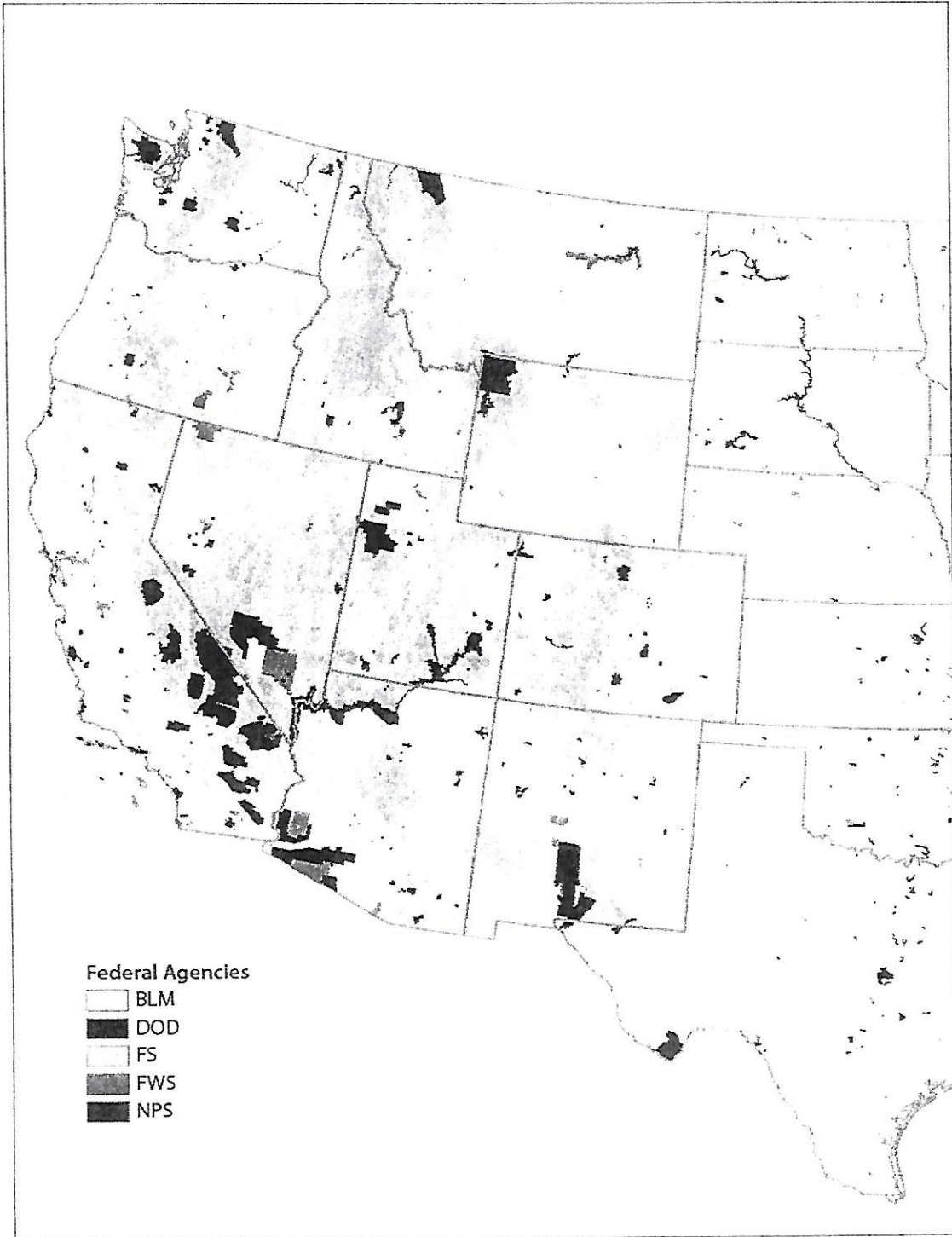

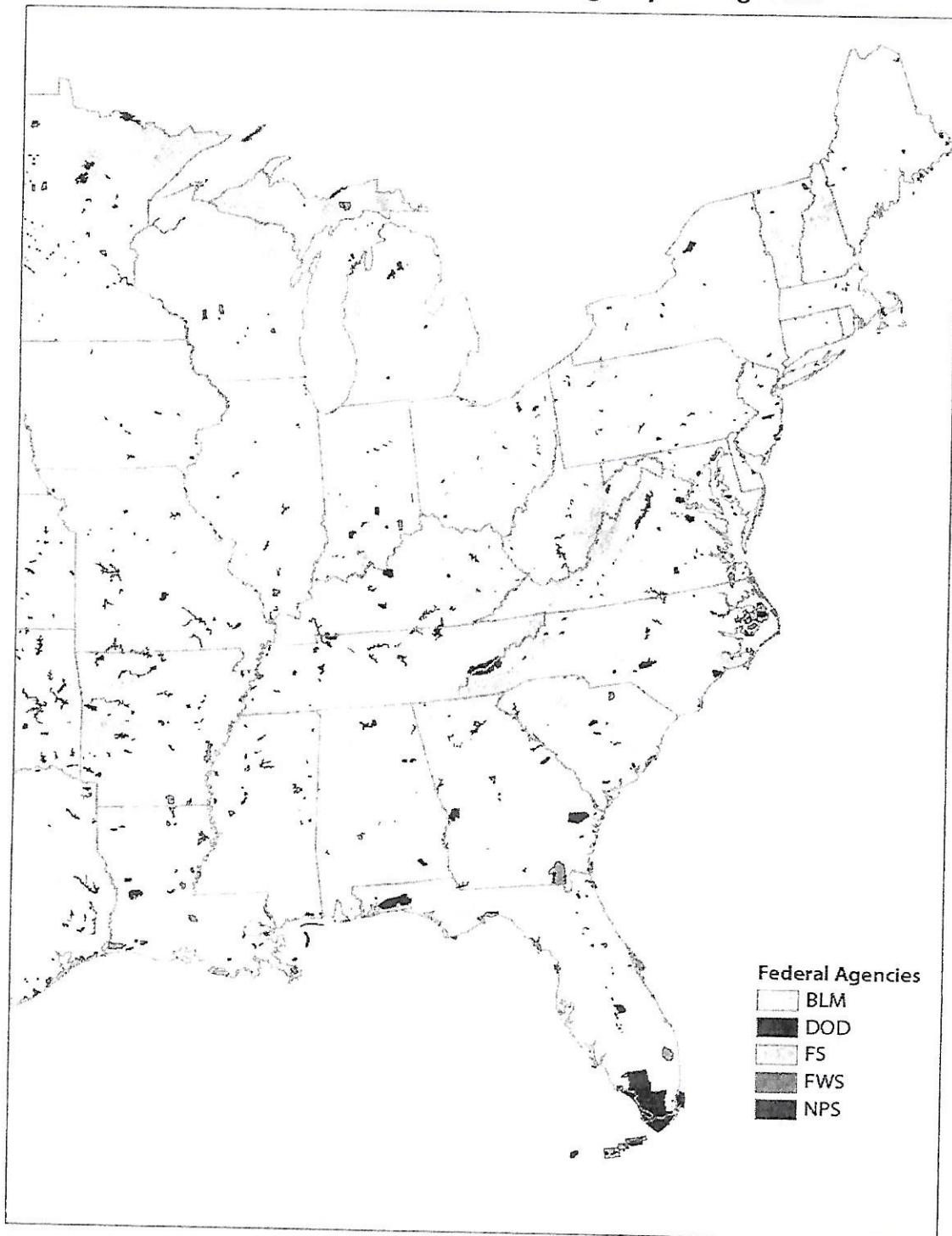
Figure I. Western Federal Lands Managed by Five Agencies
