## FY 2023 President's Budget Request

Account	Increase
Hospitals and Health Clinics	+ 215 million above FY 2022 enacted
PRC	+ 206 million
National CHAP	+ 20 million
Ending HIV/Hep C	+ 47 million
Opioids Grant	+9 million
Maternal Health	+ 4 million
EHR	+ 140 million
Cancer initiative	+ 8 million
Emergency medical services (EMS)	+ 20 million
Emergency preparedness	+ 10 million
Total:	+2.5 billion



#### FY 2023 Budget Updates

- House Appropriations Committee approves Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies funding bill, including \$8.1 billion for IHS—a \$1.5 billion increase over FY 2022.
  - Notable increases include:
    - + 1.1B for H&HC
    - + 112M for PRC
    - + 141M for M&I
    - + 140M for EHR Modernization
    - + 47M for Hep C and HIV
    - + 20M for CHAP

  - iPad Curriculum received from AK and being adapted to NW
  - Partnership with Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, Office of Native Education (WA) established to discuss partnership with CTE programs at STECs and ESSA

- The Tribal Community Health Aide Advisory Workgroup meet in June 2022 to begin establishing the baseline requirements for the Portland Area CHAP providers.

- Through the rest of 2022, the project will:
  - Work with Northwest Indian College, Lummi Nation, and the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Reservation to establish an education program for Community Health Aides
  - Work with curriculum experts to build the curriculum
  - Through the Tribal Community Health Aide Advisory Workgroup, review the CHA/P sections of PACCB Standards and Procedures
