HOUSE BILL NO. 806

BY APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE IDAHO COMMISSION FOR LIBRARIES; AP-
PROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE IDAHO COMMISSION FOR LIBRARIES FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2023; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT PO-
SITIONS; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY; REAFFIRMING STATUTORY
COMPLIANCE REGARDING OBSCENE MATERIAL; PROVIDING AGENCY DIRECTION FOR
TECHNOLOGY PROJECTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFEC-
TIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Idaho Commission for Li-
braries the following amounts to be expended according to the designated ex-
penditure classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2022, through June
30, 2023:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
Idaho Code, the Idaho Commission for Libraries is authorized no more than
thirty-seven and five-tenths (37.50) full-time equivalent positions at any
point during the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, unless specifi-
cally authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Commit-
tee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

1 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated
2 to the Idaho Commission for Libraries any unexpended and unencumbered bal-
3 ances appropriated to the Idaho Commission for Libraries from the American
4 Rescue Plan Fund for fiscal year 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$2,300,000,
5 to be used for nonrecurring expenditures for the period July 1, 2022, through
6 June 30, 2023. The Office of the State Controller shall confirm the reappro-
7 priation amount, by fund, expense class, and program, with the Legislative
8 Services Office prior to processing the reappropriation authorized herein.

9 SECTION 4. OBSCENE MATERIAL. The Idaho Commission for Libraries shall,
10 to the maximum extent possible with available staffing and resources: (1)
11 Verify that the Commission's library resources for K-12 students comply
12 with Sections 18-1514, 33-137, and 33-5208, Idaho Code; (2) Incorporate
13 references to relevant statutes regarding obscene material in the Commis-
14 sion's Electronic Resources Collection Development Policy; and (3) Provide
15 a written report to the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee no later than
16 September 1, 2022, detailing progress in complying with this section and any
17 associated internal audits.

18 SECTION 5. TECHNOLOGY PROJECTS. Moneys appropriated in Section 1 of
19 this act from the ARPA Capital Projects Fund shall be expended for technology
20 projects that comply with Section 33-2741, Idaho Code, and the federal Chil-
21 dren's Internet Protection Act. Presumptively eligible projects include
22 network infrastructure and access points that are able to provide advanced
23 threat protection and high-quality content filtering. Nothing in this sec-
24 tion shall prevent expansion to existing library facilities in connection
25 with technology projects.

26 SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
27 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
28 July 1, 2022.
