2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND ENCOURAGING THE RECOGNITION OF JAN-  
3 UARY 22 AS IDAHO'S DAY OF TEARS TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE LOSS OF LIFE FROM THE  
4 MILLIONS OF UNBORN CHILDREN SINCE THE SUPREME COURT'S DECISION IN ROE V.  
5 WADE.

6 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Idaho:

7 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives finds that on January 22, 1973,  
8 the majority of the members of the Supreme Court ruled that abortion was a  
9 right secured by the Constitution; and

10 WHEREAS, since that fateful day, more than 62 million unborn children  
11 have perished.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the House of Represen-  
13 tatives, assembled in the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth Idaho  
14 Legislature, that January 22, in perpetuity, hereby be recognized as the Day  
15 of Tears in Idaho and that the citizens of Idaho be encouraged to lower their  
16 flags to half-staff to mourn the innocents who have lost their lives to abor-  
17 tion.
