2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND SUPPORTING THE OBLIGA-
3 TION OF \$100,000 IN ARPA FUNDS FOR THE EXTRADITION TRANSPORT COSTS OF
4 THE COMMISSION OF PARDONS AND PAROLE.

5 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA), P.L. 117-2, was
7 passed by Congress and signed into law; and

8 WHEREAS, ARPA allocated \$1,094,018,353 to the State of Idaho for the
9 State Fiscal Recovery Fund; and

10 WHEREAS, projects associated with the State Fiscal Recovery Fund must
11 be obligated by December 31, 2024, and expended by December 31, 2026; and

12 WHEREAS, one of the four allowable uses of the State Fiscal Recovery
13 Fund is to respond to the economic impacts of COVID-19; and

14 WHEREAS, the Northwest Shuttle service extradites parolees from 15
15 other states back to Idaho at no cost to the Commission of Pardons and Parole;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the Northwest Shuttle service suspended operations due to the
18 impact of COVID-19.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the House of Represen-
20 tatives, assembled in the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth Idaho
21 Legislature, that the House of Representatives supports the obligation of
22 \$100,000 in ARPA funds for the extradition transport costs of the Commission
23 of Pardons and Parole as bridge funding for extradition costs until a perma-
24 nent solution can be found.
