

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS29643 / S1354

This legislation allows high school students who have completed two years of high school to enroll in a licensed barber or cosmetology program and begin accruing training hours during their junior year. The legislation clarifies the previous age requirement of sixteen and one-half years old applies to the qualification for licensure at the time of application. A high school student enrolled in a licensed program may be under sixteen and one-half years of age while accruing the course of instruction hours required for licensure.

FISCAL NOTE

This legislation will have no impact on the State's General Fund or any dedicated fund or federal fund because the proposed legislation does not change any fee schedules or financially impact the Barbers and Cosmetology Board or Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses dedicated fund.
