SENATE BILL NO. 1406

BY FINANCE COMMITTEE

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE; AP-
PROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2023; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSI-
TIONS; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2022; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
of State the following amounts to be expended according to the designated
programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1,
2022, through June 30, 2023:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
Idaho Code, the Office of the Secretary of State is authorized no more than
twenty-nine (29.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the
period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, unless specifically authorized
by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be noti-
fied promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-
ter 190, Laws of 2021, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is
hereby appropriated to the office of the Secretary of State \$50,000 from the
General Fund to be expended for operating expenditures for the period July 1,
2021, through June 30, 2022, for the purpose of election integrity audits.

1 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
2 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
3 passage and approval.
