





70,616 units of blood donated at 2,243 blood drives



Provided support and emergency services for 3,440 military families and veterans



Trained 20,005 people in CPR, first aid, and AED and 20 people trained in Fort Hall



585 Volunteers contributed 42,533 hours





- Chartered in 1914

- Reach over 100,000 people each year
- Volunteers respond to a house fire every day
- 24 staff in Idaho and Montana, 951 volunteers
- 90 cents of every dollar donated goes toward program and services

## Youth Preparedness

Educating youth on how to prevent, prepare for, and cope with disasters.





- Prepare with Pedro
  - •Kindergarten 2nd Grade
  - •Engages children with Pedro the Penguin to learn how to be prepared and take action during an emergency
- Pillowcase Project
  - •3rd Grade 5th Grade
  - Covers local hazards, coping skills, and personal and family preparedness



#### Home Fire Campaign

Make homes safer and minimize fire fatalities by installing smoke alarms and

educating families in fire prevention.

Partner with local fire departments

#### Sound the Alarm events:

Canvassing events in which we offer free smoke alarm installation to residents in at-risk neighborhoods. This campaign aims to reduce deaths and injuries by home fires by 25%.



## **Disaster Relief Operations**

Provide emergency relief to those affected by disasters or during large-scale responses. We work closely with Tribal and County Emergency Management and other agencies.

- Feeding
- Distribution of Emergency Supplies
- Government Operations Liaisons
- Community Engagement & Partnerships







# Case Study- Clearwater Complex Wildfire

68 homes in the area sustained damage or were lost

- 54 volunteers deployed.
- 111 overnight stays; 181 clients served
- 3,482 meals and snacks served
- Multi Agency Resource Center
- Long-term recovery group convened and coordinated 81 agencies, companies and partners.
