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
Key points

- True cost containment requires reducing service costs, use, or enrollment




Cost growth is unrelated to admin model

Utah managed care cost growth




 Utah compound growth rate for total spending is similar to Idaho Utah Pre-2020 PMPM growth is much faster than in Idaho





Nebraska managed care cost growth



 Nebraska has higher total and PMPM costs than Idaho More than 50% comprehensive MCO coverage for decades


Medicaid spending change over time

The iron law of Medicaid cost control

- Reduce enrollment: **Remove ineligibles and repeal expansion**
- Reduce the cost of services: Full audit of provider billing practices
- Reduce service consumption: State prescription benefit autonomy
