#### BY REVENUE AND TAXATION COMMITTEE

RELATING TO INCOME TAXES; AMENDING SECTION 63-3004, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF "INTERNAL REVENUE CODE"; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING RETROACTIVE APPLICATION.

#### HOUSE BILL NO. 22

#### BY STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

#### AN ACT

RELATING TO SALES AND USE TAX; AMENDING CHAPTER 36, TITLE 63, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 63-3642, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE WITHHOLDING OF SALES AND USE TAX FROM CITY AND COUNTY GOVERNMENTS IN CERTAIN INSTANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
