AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL COMMISSION FOR

FISCAL YEAR 2024; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL

COMMISSION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED

FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY;

PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND

PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Idaho Public Charter School Commission the following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Idaho Public Charter School Commission is authorized no more than six (6.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated to the Idaho Public Charter School Commission any unexpended and unencumbered balances appropriated or reappropriated to the Idaho Public Charter School Commission from the Public Charter School Authorizers Fund for fiscal year 2023, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures, for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. The State Controller shall confirm the reappropriation amount, by fund, expense class, and program, with the Legislative Services Office prior to processing the reappropriation authorized herein.

SECTION 4. ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. Funds specifically identified in statute or in an appropriation act as intended for a certain purpose may be

- used only for that purpose. All funds provided in this act shall be subject
 to accountability reports and management reviews in accordance with Section
 67-702, Idaho Code.
- SECTION 5. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2023.
