## HOUSE BILL NO. 369

## BY APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE; AP-2 PROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE FOR THE DIVI-3 SION OF MEDICAID FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED 4 FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; PROVIDING FOR GENERAL FUND TRANSFERS 5 TO THE COOPERATIVE WELFARE FUND; DIRECTING EXPENDITURES FOR TRUSTEE 6 AND BENEFIT PAYMENTS; PROVIDING REQUIREMENTS FOR PROGRAM INTEGRITY; 7 REQUIRING MONTHLY MEDICAID TRACKING REPORTS; ALLOWING FOR TRANSFER 8 OF APPROPRIATIONS BETWEEN PROGRAMS; REQUIRING A REPORT ON MEDICAID 9 MANAGED CARE IMPLEMENTATION; REQUIRING COST-SHARING FOR SERVICES; 10 PROVIDING REQUIREMENTS FOR BUDGET INTEGRITY; LIMITING THE TRANSFER OF 11 APPROPRIATIONS; PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS; APPROPRIATING 12 ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DIVISION OF MEDICAID FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; AND 13 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 14

15 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare for the Division of Medicaid the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Medicaid Administration and Medical Management Program of the Department of Health and Welfare is authorized no more than two hundred thirteen (213.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. GENERAL FUND TRANSFERS. As appropriated, the Office of the
 State Controller shall periodically make transfers from the General Fund to
 the Cooperative Welfare Fund as requested by the director of the Department
 of Health and Welfare and approved by the Board of Examiners.

SECTION 4. TRUSTEE AND BENEFIT PAYMENTS. Notwithstanding the provi sions of Section 67-3511, Idaho Code, funds appropriated in the trustee and
 benefit payments expense class shall not be transferred to any other expense
 classes during fiscal year 2024.

SECTION 5. PROGRAM INTEGRITY. Notwithstanding any other provision of
 law to the contrary, the Department of Health and Welfare shall be required
 to provide those services authorized or mandated by law in each program, only

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to the extent of funding appropriated and available resources for each budgeted program.

SECTION 6. MEDICAID TRACKING REPORT. The Department of Health and Wel-3 4 fare's Division of Medicaid and Division of Indirect Support Services shall deliver a report that compares the Medicaid appropriation, distributed by 5 month for the year, to the actual expenditures and remaining forecasted ex-6 penditures for the year on a monthly basis to the Legislative Services Office 7 and the Division of Financial Management. The report shall also include a 8 forecast, updated monthly, of the next fiscal year's anticipated trustee and 9 benefit expenditures. The format of the report and the information included 10 therein shall be determined by the Legislative Services Office and the Divi-11 sion of Financial Management. 12

SECTION 7. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS. Notwithstanding the provisions 13 14 of Section 67-3511, Idaho Code, funding provided for the trustee and benefit payments expense class in the Division of Medicaid may be transferred in 15 excess of ten percent (10%) among the Coordinated Medicaid Plan, Enhanced 16 Medicaid Plan, Basic Medicaid Plan, Expansion Medicaid Plan, and the Medic-17 aid Administration and Medical Management Programs, but shall not be trans-18 19 ferred to any other budgeted program or expense class within the Department of Health and Welfare during fiscal year 2024. 20

SECTION 8. MEDICAID MANAGED CARE IMPLEMENTATION. The Division of Medicaid shall provide a report to the Legislative Services Office and the Division of Financial Management on progress in integrating managed care approaches into the state Medicaid system. The format of the report and information contained therein shall be determined by the Legislative Services Office and the Division of Financial Management. The report shall be submitted no later than December 1, 2023.

SECTION 9. COST-SHARING REQUIREMENT. The Department of Health and Wel-28 fare shall implement cost-sharing in the Division of Medicaid, as required 29 by Section 56-257, Idaho Code, to the maximum extent that is federally allow-30 able for the expanded population of children whose families' gross taxable 31 income exceeds one hundred eighty-five percent (185%) but does not exceed 32 three hundred percent (300%) of the federal poverty limit (FPL), for Medic-33 aid-eligible services as identified in House Bill No. 43, as enacted by the 34 First Regular Session of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature. 35

SECTION 10. BUDGET INTEGRITY. Notwithstanding any other provision of 36 law to the contrary, and consistent with its cost containment strategy, the 37 Department of Health and Welfare's Division of Medicaid shall submit its 38 budget request in accordance with applicable Idaho law as of the date of 39 40 submission. This section does not prohibit the agency from making requests of the Legislature that would impact any portion of the department's budget. 41 However, any proposed changes to Idaho Code with an anticipated budgetary 42 impact shall be identified in narrative form only, without numerical en-43 tries. Further, the department shall submit its budget request based on the 44 forecasted amount for the most recent month available from the report iden-45

tified in Section 6 of this act and for the estimated needs of maintaining operations of the division.

3 SECTION 11. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS. Pursuant to Section 4 67-3511(4), Idaho Code, funding provided for the personnel costs expense 5 class in the Division of Medicaid shall not be transferred to any other 6 expense class within the Department of Health and Welfare during fiscal year 7 2024.

8 SECTION 12. ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. Funds specifically identified in 9 statute or in an appropriation act as intended for a certain purpose may be 10 used only for that purpose. All funds provided in this act shall be subject 11 to accountability reports and management reviews in accordance with Section 12 67-702, Idaho Code.

SECTION 13. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 252, Laws of 2022, and any other appropriation provided for by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare for the Enhanced Medicaid Plan the following amounts to be expended for trustee and benefit payments from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023:
