1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND APPROVING FEE RULES OF THE DIVISION
3 OF OCCUPATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL LICENSES REVIEWED BY THE HOUSE ENVI-
4 RONMENT, ENERGY, AND TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE AND SENATE HEALTH AND WELFARE
5 COMMITTEE.

6 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
8 agency rules that are not consistent with legislative intent and to approve
9 executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, the Legislature, pursuant to Section 67-5224, Idaho Code, must
12 approve certain administrative rules that impose a fee or charge by adoption
13 of a concurrent resolution before the rules become effective; and

14 WHEREAS, the House Environment, Energy, and Technology Committee and
15 the Senate Health and Welfare Committee reviewed fee rules adopted by the
16 Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses, Rules of the Board of
17 Drinking Water and Wastewater Professionals; and

18 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that it is in the public interest to
19 adopt this resolution.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
21 sion of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives
22 and the Senate concurring therein, that all fee rules adopted by the Divi-
23 sion of Occupational and Professional Licenses, Rules of the Board of Drink-
24 ing Water and Wastewater Professionals, pursuant to the Administrative Pro-
25 cedure Act and submitted through the Office of the Administrative Rules Co-
26 ordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2023 legislative session
27 and reviewed by the House Environment, Energy, and Technology Committee and
28 Senate Health and Welfare Committee, be, and the same are approved.
