#### SENATE BILL NO. 1078

#### BY STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

AN ACT

- RELATING TO VOTERS; AMENDING TITLE 34, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A 2 NEW CHAPTER 8, TITLE 34, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS REGARD-3 ING VOTERS' GUIDES TO BE PREPARED AND DISTRIBUTED BY THE SECRETARY OF 4 5 STATE; AMENDING SECTION 34-1812C, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR VOTERS' GUIDES AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION; AMENDING SECTION 67-453, 6 IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE A PROVISION REGARDING VOTERS' PAMPHLETS AND TO 7 MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN 8 EFFECTIVE DATE. 9
- 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Title 34, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW CHAPTER</u>, to be known and designated as Chapter 8, Title 34, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

## CHAPTER 8 VOTERS' GUIDES

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16 34-801. VOTERS' GUIDE -- DUTY OF SECRETARY OF STATE -- PURPOSE. The 17 secretary of state shall prepare and distribute a voters' guide before each 18 primary and general election in accordance with the provisions of this chap-19 ter. The purpose of the voters' guide is to provide electors with uniform 20 information about issues, measures, and candidates to be voted on in primary 21 and general elections.

34-802. VOTERS' GUIDE -- CONTENT -- FORM. (1) The secretary of state
 shall prescribe the form and arrangement of content for the voters' guide.
 The voters' guide shall contain the following information:
 (a) In each general election at which an initiative or referendum mode.

   number and form in which the ballot title thereof will be printed

- (iv) A copy of the arguments and rebuttals for and against
   each state measure submitted pursuant to sections 34-1812A and
   34-1812B, Idaho Code.
- (b) In each election at which a proposal to amend the constitution of
   the state of Idaho is to be submitted to the electors, presentation of
   major arguments submitted by the legislative council and the text of the
   proposed amendment;

(c) The names of candidates for state and federal offices that will ap-1 2 pear on the ballot; (d) If timely submitted by a candidate for state or federal office: 3 (i) A statement not exceeding two hundred (200) words; 4 (ii) The candidate's campaign contact information; and 5 (iii) The candidate's photograph, which shall not be more than 6 7 four (4) years old and shall be in a format the secretary of state determines suitable for reproduction in the voters' quide; and 8 (e) Any additional information relating to elections as is required by 9 law or in the discretion of the secretary of state is deemed informative 10 11 to the electors. (2) Statements, information, and photographs submitted by candidates 12 pursuant to this section must be received in the office of the secretary of 13 state within seven (7) days after the filing deadline set forth in section 14 34-704, Idaho Code, in order to be included in the voters' quide. 15 16 (3) The voters' guide shall be printed: (a) On pages no smaller than 6 x 9 inches in size; 17 (b) In clear, readable type that is no less than 10-point, except that 18 the text of any measure may be set forth in no less than 7-point type; and 19 (c) On a quality and weight of paper that, in the judgment of the secre-20 21 tary of state, best serves the voters. DISTRIBUTION OF VOTERS' GUIDES. (1) No later than thirty (30) 22 34-803. days before the election for which the voters' guide has been prepared, the 23 24 secretary of state shall distribute the voters' guide to every household in 25 the state. (2) Sufficient copies of the voters' guide shall be sent to each county 26 clerk. The secretary of state and county clerks shall make copies of the vot-27 ers' quide available upon request. 28 (3) The secretary of state may make all information provided in the vot-29 ers' guide available on its official website. 30 SECTION 2. That Section 34-1812C, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 31 amended to read as follows: 32 34-1812C. VOTERS' PAMPHLET. (1) Not later than September 25 before any 33 34 regular general election at which an initiative or referendum measure is to be submitted to the people, the secretary of state shall cause to be printed a 35 36 voters' pamphlet which that shall contain the following: (a) A complete copy of the title and text of each measure with the number 37 and form in which the ballot title thereof will be printed on the offi-38 cial ballot; 39 (b) A copy of the fiscal impact statement summary for a state measure; 40 (c) A copy of the sponsor's proposed funding source information for a 41 state measure; and 42 (d) A copy of the arguments and rebuttals for and against each state 43 44 measure. 45 (2) The secretary of state shall mail or distribute a copy of the vot-46 ers' pamphlet to every household in the state. Sufficient copies of the voters' pamphlet shall also be sent to each county clerk. The county clerk and 47

the secretary of state shall make copies of the voters' pamphlet available 1 2 upon request. (3) The voters' pamphlet shall be printed according to the following 3 specifications: 4 5 (a) The pages of the pamphlet shall be not smaller than  $6 \times 9$  inches in size; 6 (b) It shall be printed in clear, readable type, no less than 10-point, 7 except that the text of any measure may be set forth in no less than 8 7-point type; 9 10 (c) It shall be printed on a quality and weight of paper that, in the judgment of the secretary of state, best serves the voters; 11 (d) If the material described in subsection (1) of this section is com-12 bined in a single publication with constitutional amendments, the en-13 tire publication shall be treated as a legal notice. 14 (4) If a voters' guide that meets the requirements of this section has 15 16 been prepared pursuant to chapter 8, title 34, Idaho Code, then the secretary of state shall be deemed to have complied with this section. 17

18 SECTION 3. That Section 67-453, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 19 amended to read as follows:

67-453. STATEMENTS REGARDING PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS. (1) Whenever the legislature shall have directed the submission of a proposal to amend the constitution of the state of Idaho to the electors, the legislative council shall, not less than one hundred twenty (120) days prior to the date of the election at which the proposed amendment will be submitted to the people, prepare and file with the secretary of state a dossier containing the following:

(a) A brief statement setting forth in simple, understandable language
the meaning and purpose of the proposed amendment and the result to be
accomplished by such amendment. The statement shall be included in the
publications of the proposed amendment required by law of the secretary
of state<sub>r</sub> and shall be printed on the official ballot by which such proposed amendment is submitted to the electors; and

(b) A concise presentation of the major arguments advanced by the pro-33 ponents and opponents of the proposed amendment designed to represent 34 as fairly as possible the arguments relative to the proposed amend-35 ment. In preparing such arguments, the legislative council may seek 36 the advice and suggestions of known supporters and opponents or any 37 other persons or groups and may, in its sole discretion, use any of the 38 suggested arguments. If any such suggestions are utilized by the leg-39 islative council, no recognition shall be given to the persons or groups 40 which that submitted the argument. The arguments shall be published in 41 42 the publications required by law of the secretary of state, but shall not appear on the ballot by which such proposed amendment is submitted 43 44 to the electors.

(2) The secretary of state shall cause to be printed in either the voters' pamphlet pursuant to section 34-1812C, Idaho Code, or in a pamphlet similar to the voters' pamphlet voters' guide pursuant to chapter 8, title 34,
Idaho Code, the arguments prepared pursuant to subsection (1) of this section and the question that will be on the general election ballot.

SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
July 1, 2023.
