- 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
 - SECTION 1. That Section 67-465, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 67-465. INTERVENTION IN ACTIONS REGARDING CONSTITUTIONALITY OF A AN IDAHO STATUTE. When a party to an action challenges in state or federal court the constitutionality of an Idaho statute, facially or as applied, challenges an Idaho statute as violating or being preempted by federal law, or otherwise challenges the construction or validity of an Idaho statute, either or both houses of the legislature may intervene, at the sole discretion of the senate president pro tempore or the speaker of the house of representatives, or both, in the action as a matter of right by serving filing a motion upon the parties in the court as provided in state or federal rules of civil procedure, whichever is applicable.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2023.
