2 STATING LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND APPROVING FEE RULES OF THE IDAHO STATE
3 POLICE / IDAHO PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY INFORMATION SYSTEMS AND THE
4 SEXUAL OFFENDER MANAGEMENT BOARD REVIEWED BY THE SENATE JUDICIARY AND
5 RULES COMMITTEE AND HOUSE JUDICIARY, RULES, AND ADMINISTRATION COMMIT-
6 TEE.

7 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
9 agency rules that are not consistent with legislative intent and to approve
10 executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, the Legislature, pursuant to Section 67-5224, Idaho Code, must
13 approve certain administrative rules that impose a fee or charge by adoption
14 of a concurrent resolution before the rules become effective; and

15 WHEREAS, the Senate Judiciary and Rules Committee and the House Judi-
16 ciary, Rules, and Administration Committee reviewed fee rules adopted by the
17 Idaho State Police / Idaho Public Safety and Security Information Systems
18 and the Sexual Offender Management Board; and

19 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that it is in the public interest to
20 adopt this resolution.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
22 sion of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of
23 Representatives concurring therein, that all fee rules adopted by the Idaho
24 State Police / Idaho Public Safety and Security Information Systems and the
25 Sexual Offender Management Board pursuant to the Administrative Procedure
26 Act and submitted through the Office of the Administrative Rules Coordina-
27 tor to the Legislature for review during the 2023 legislative session and
28 reviewed by the Senate Judiciary and Rules Committee and House Judiciary,
29 Rules, and Administration Committee, be, and the same are approved.
