

## Regulatory Scope

- In order to prevent the spread of brucellosis and other diseases between big game animals to livestock, these rules apply to all persons who purposely or knowingly of these rules, except supplemental feeding activities conducted by, or emergency feeding authorized by, the Idaho Dept. of Fish and Game (IDFG). provide supplemental feed to big game animals within the area designated in Section 100
- IDFG facilitated a Zero-Based Rulemaking (ZBR) re-write of IDAPA 13.01.18 Rules the potential to consolidate regulations under IDFG's authority in this rule chapter. Governing Feeding of Wild Cervids (Docket No. 13-0118-2201). ISDA and IDFG evaluated
