

Registrations and Licenses

- The rule is comprised of 5 registration/licensing subchapters that are important to:
- Commercial feed, fertilizer, and soil and plant amendment registrants who sell or distribute products in the state of Idaho
- Nurseries and florists that require special services
- Beekeepers maintaining hives, colonies, or apiaries within the state of Idaho

Combination of Rules

- Combination of 5 Registration/Licensing Rules (2019)
- All registration/licensing rules combined as sub-chapters
- All the result of general registration and labeling requirements or licensing procedures
- IBR

Negotiated Rulemaking Meetings

- Public meetings were conducted via video conference
- Strong, broad-based participation from stakeholders who engaged in meeting discussions
- No written comments or post-meeting feedback submitted to the rulemaking record

- Publication that governs the laboratory testing requirements of animal feeds was updated to current version

Human grade claim documentation

- Definition of "Human-Grade" is incorporated by reference with the AAFCO Official Publication.
- Requires extensive evaluation of documentation supporting safety claims and suitability of commercial feeds for human consumption
- Supporting documentation still required to substantiate claims
- Not reviewed as part of the label approval process.
