**Chairman Skaug** called the meeting to order at 1:30pm.

**Chairman Skaug** turned the gavel over to **Vice Chairman Scott**.

**DOCKET NO. 11-0702-2201:** **Lieutenant Gardiner** of the Idaho State Police presented the rule in **Docket No. 11-0702-2201** governing safety glazing and proposed repeal of the rule due to redundancy with current statute.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Garner** made a motion to approve **Docket No. 11-0702-2201**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**DOCKET NO. 57-0101-2201:** **Nancy Volle**, program manager of the Sexual Offender Management Board, presented rule changes to eliminate redundant information.

**Vice Chairman Scott** put the committee at ease at 1:42pm.

**Vice Chairman Scott** returned the meeting to order at 1:46pm.

**Ms. Volle** presented line item changes and responded to questions.

**DOCKET NO. 11-1003-2201:** **Supervisor Amy Campbell** of the Sex Offender Registry, presented the rules governing the Sex Offender Registry. Discussion followed regarding the changes in expunged records of sex offender deaths, compliance in reducing redundancy, and concerns regarding code.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Mathias** made a motion to approve **Docket No.11-1003-2201** with the exception of proposed .06. a. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**Vice Chairman Scott** turned over the gavel to **Chairman Skaug**.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Garner** made a motion to approve the January 19, 2023 meeting minutes. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**RS 30063:** **Rep. Scott** presented details of **RS 30063** regarding malicious or false reporting of child abuse to Child Protective Services. The proposed legislation applies the same disciplinary actions for perjury to those knowingly making false reports of child abuse to Child Protective Services.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Young** made a motion to introduce **RS 30063** with the following changes: on line 12 insert "false" before report and strike "or an allegation," on line 13 strike "or allegation," on line 14 strike "or allegation" and "or with malice." **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**ADJOURN:** There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 3:01pm.
