#### Idaho Code Chapter 21, Title 33

North Idaho College was established under and is governed by Chapter 21 of Title 33 of Idaho Code. The primary function of NIC, as stated in Idaho Code, is "instruction in academic subjects, and in such non-academic subjects as shall be authorized by its board of trustees" (Section 33-2102, Idaho Code).
