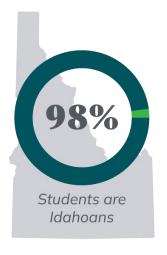

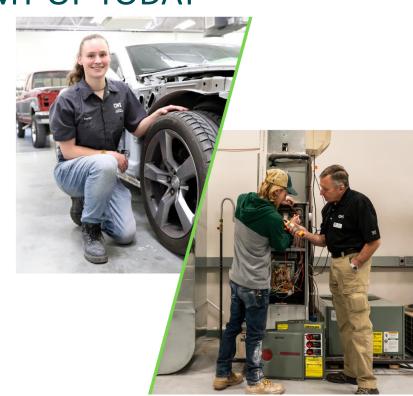








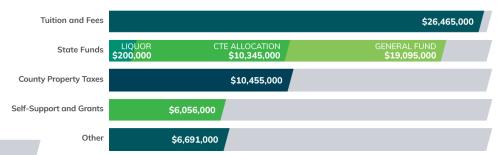

## FY 2024 - AGRICULTURAL/ HORTICULTURE PROGRAM EXPANSION

- Phase 2 of Agricultural and Horticulture expansion
- Total Project Cost \$8M
- Capital Budget Request \$5M
- CWI \$3M
- Scope of Program Expansion
  - Integrating diverse learning spaces
  - Enhancing experiential learning opportunities with barns, greenhouses and animal facilities
  - Provides cross-departmental synergies between programs



#### FY 2024 – STUDENT LEARNING HUB

- Phase 1 of a new Student Learning Hub
- Total Project Cost \$22M
- Capital Budget Request -\$10.7M
- CWI \$11.3M
- Project Scope 35,000 sf.
  - **Consolidation** student resources from across the Treasure Valley would consolidate into one facility on the Nampa Campus. Reduction of leased spaces.
  - **Services Scope** Career Services, Employer/Student Demonstration Facility, Tutoring, Entrepreneurship Lab Space, Library and Technology Commons, and Bookstore.
  - **Centralization** positions CWI as a destination for employers and community to engage students in one central location.



### **GOVERNOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 1. Governor Initiative Institution Funding: \$379,100 ILO Line Items
  - Increase Nursing Capacity, STEM Student Capacity Increase, Student Outreach and Recruitment
- Permanent Building Fund: Student Learning Hub and Agricultural/Horticulture Expansion \$15.7M
- 3. Change in Employee Compensation (4.0%) \$549,700
- **4. Health Benefits:** \$179,300
- 5. Change in Variable Benefit: (\$23,900)
- **6. EWA**: (\$766,000)
