



The Idaho Military Division's statutory authority to operate is governed by Title 46 of Idaho Code.

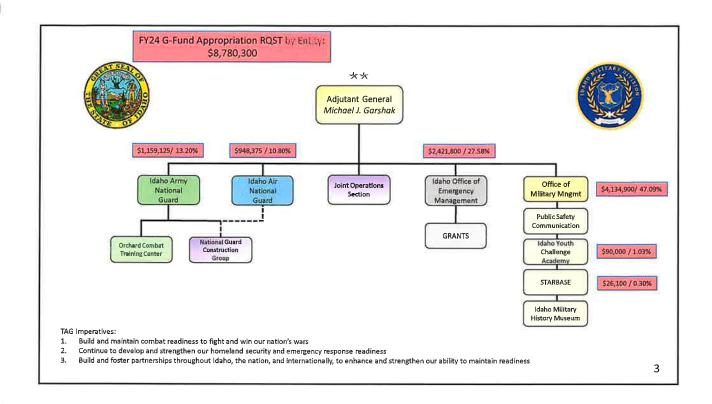

General Fund

Out of the \$6,137,100 variance in General funds, \$1,556,200 was Legislative Reappropriation and \$4,580,900 was Executive Carry Forward. There was no reverted funds in the General Fund account.

Federal Grant Fund

Out of the \$24,087,200 variance in the Federal Grant Fund, \$8,520,900 was Executive Carry Forward. \$15,566,300 was Reverted as excess federal spending authority.

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2023 Supplemental Requests:

- (LBB 6-120 #1) ARPA Fund Adjustment Moves \$253,600 to the correct ARPA Fund
- (LBB 6-120 #2) Enhanced Fire Audit for \$500,000
 Expands contract to examine all federal and state funding for wildfires in Idaho
- (LBB 6-120) HazMat Deficiency Warrants for \$8,100
 \$8,100 from the General Fund to be moved to the Hazardous Substance Emergency Response Fund to cover hazardous material incidents not reimbursed by the responsible party.

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2024 Line Item Requests:

- (LBB 6-122 #1) Additional Operating Expenditures \$41,000 in ongoing general fund dollars to meet the federal match requirements to support emergency preparation activities across the state.
- (LBB 6-122 #2) Personnel Fund Shift
 Transfer of 0.25 FTP from the Federal Fund to the General Fund to cover the
 25% match requirement for a Grounds Maintenance and Equipment Operator.
 Additionally, this request includes a General Funds transfer of \$20,000 from operating to personnel to cover the state match requirement.
- (LBB 6-123 #3) Cybersecurity

Ongoing funds in the amount of \$3,750,000 for five years from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) to develop cybersecurity response plans for all Idaho counties and Tribes and create a cybersecurity fusion center.

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2024 Line Item Requests (cont'd):

- (LBB 6-123) DHR Consolidation
 The Governor recommends an increase of \$197,700 to consolidate existing human resource positions under the Division of Human Resources. \$28,900 comes out of the General Fund.
- (LBB 6-123) Budget Law Exemptions/Other Adjustments
 Carry over authority for an enhanced fire audit from the General Fund in an amount not to
 exceed \$500,000 from FY 2023 into FY2024.
