## CHALLENGES

- SKILLED NURSING STAFF SHORTAGE
- VACANCY RATE IS $19 \%$ WITH 80\% OF THOSE BEING SKILLED NURSING STAFF
- 30\% TURNOVER FOR SKILLED NURSING STAFF
- COVID/INFLATIONARY COSTS
- OVERALL COSTS HAVE INCREASE 30\% ON AVERAGE
