- Provide high wage, career advancing opportunities in rural and urban Idaho

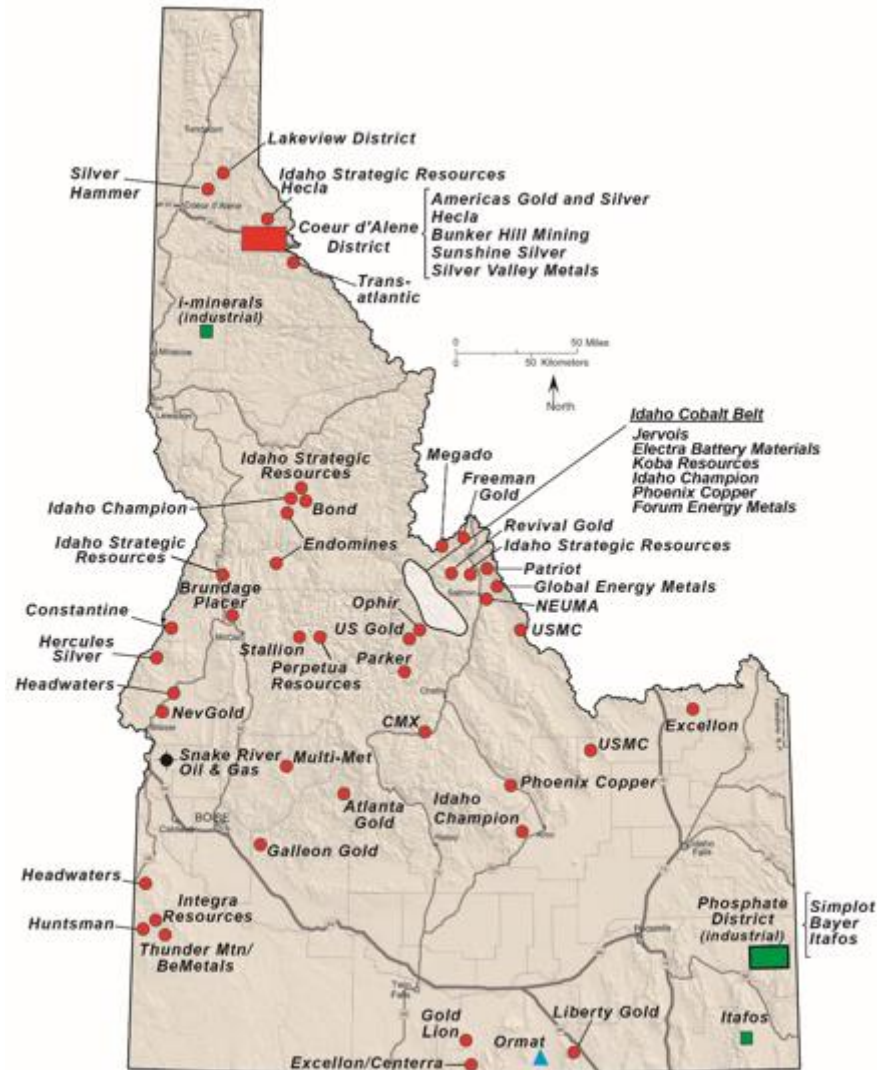
What We Believe.

What We Contribute.

- ⚒ More than 10,500 direct/indirect jobs

- ⚒ More than \$735 million in total compensation
 - Average compensation package for a mining related job is roughly \$106,000 annually or 72% higher than the average Idaho salary

- ⚒ More than \$130 million in state and local taxes

 - Royalties

- ⚒ More than \$1.4 billion in gross state product
