



Title 42, Idaho Code

Administers water rights, performs regulatory functions, and develops tools and resources to record and monitor Idaho's water supply

ID Water Resource Bd

Article XV, Section 7 of Idaho Const Section 42-1732, Idaho Code

Implement state water plan, financing water projects, sustainable management projects, long-term vision and policy



Continuously Appropriated Funds

<u>Secondary Aquifer Fund</u>. Moneys are used for technical studies, project management services, hydrologic monitoring, measurement and comprehensive plan development, as well as for personnel costs, operating expenditures, capital outlay and water projects associated with the statewide comprehensive aquifer planning and management effort [§42-1780(2), Idaho Code].

Revolving Development Fund. Moneys are used to make loans for projects which further implement the Idaho State Water Plan in the public interest. The projects are reviewed and approved by the board according to §42-1750 to §42-1759, Idaho Code.

<u>Water Management Fund</u>. Funds used may be used for new water projects or the rehabilitation of existing water projects limited to reclamation, upstream storage, off-stream storage, aquifer recharge, reservoir site acquisition and protection, water supply, water quality, recreation, and water resource studies, including feasibility studies for qualifying projects [§42-1760, Idaho Code].
