




Distribution of Federal Funding from COVID-19 Programs by State



ldaho Approach to Use of Funds (S 1204)

- allowable under law, the state should make <mark>long-range investments</mark> that ARPA funds are borrowed from our grandchildren. To the extent will benefit our grandchildren.
- State agencies receiving ARPA funds shall <mark>plan for the reduction</mark> of these federal funds to avoid creating ongoing obligations that are shifted to the general fund after the federal funds are depleted.
- The use of ARPA funds should not impede or inhibit the state's constitutional mandate to provide for a <mark>balanced budget</mark>.
