Chairman Skaug called the meeting to order at 1:31pm.

MOTION: **Rep. Alfieri** made a motion to approve the February 21, 2023 meeting minutes. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

Erica McGinnis, Chief Clerk of the House, presented the Joint Printing Committee Report.

Director Monty Prow presented the Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections Performance Report.

Committee inquired regarding efforts to reduce staff turnover, objective goals, family satisfaction measures, the definition of success, the increase in recidivism, the impact of community services, what entity determines the length of custody, and which entities provide chapel services.

Anisha Jones, Technical Records Specialist, presented the Idaho Racing Commission Performance Report.

Committee inquired regarding the Racing Commission having only two performance measures, fluctuations in spending, explanation of the totalizer system, other possible revenue streams, and measures to increase attendance.

Ardie Noyes, Operations Manager of the Idaho Racing Commission, presented the challenges from increased competition from surrounding states and other betting venues.

Committee inquired regarding strict regulation, non-profit event options, and types of horse racing.
