Chairman Weber called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.
RS 30374: **Rep. Lambert** presented **RS 30374**. This memorial regards the federal government's lawsuit claiming jurisdiction over Idaho's water rights. It asks the governor to enlist resources to fight the claim, and Idaho's congressional leaders to request the justice department withdraw the lawsuit. It also authorizes distribution of the memorial through congressional channels.
MOTION: **Rep. Rubel** made a motion to introduce **RS 30374**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
RS 30454: **Rep. Handy** presented **RS 30454**. This legislation reduces the time from five years to three years before a juvenile criminal record can be expunged.
MOTION: **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 30454**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
RS 30527: **Rep. Raybould** presented **RS 30527**. This concurrent resolution addresses the importance of Idaho's water resources. It supports ongoing planning and investment in water infrastructure throughout the state.
MOTION: **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 30527**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
RS 30501: **Rep. Palmer** presented **RS 30501**, which expands the number of allowed subdistricts within a countywide highway district to seven.
MOTION: **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 30501**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
ADJOURN: There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 8:38 a.m.
