	Chairman Holtzclaw called the meeting to order	at 10:40 a.m.
S 1167:	Rep. Blanksma presented S 1167, legislation making changes to the Idaho Launch Program by increasing legislative oversight and placing limits on parts of the program.  In response to questions from Committee members, Rep. Blanksma advised minimum academic standards refers to graduation requirements. She noted data was included in S 1167 to indicate that those enrolled in the Idaho Launch Program gain employment after completion. She noted the legislation also removes unnecessary language and grammatical errors. She advised only four year universities would be eligible for Opportunities Scholarship funds and community colleges would be eligible for Idaho Launch Program funds.  Those testifying in support were Pam Eaton, Idaho Retailers Association; Liz Hatter, Idaho State Dental Association; Caroline Troy, Higher Education; and Elizabeth Griner, Food North West. They were of the opinion S 1167 would enable greater workforce participation and address current shortages.	
MOTION:	<b>Rep. Weber</b> made a motion to send <b>S 1167</b> to the floor with a <b>DO PASS</b> recommendation. <b>Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Blanksma</b> will sponsor the bill on the floor.
