- MOTION: Rep. Galaviz made a motion to approve the minutes of March 24, 2023. Motion carried by voice vote.
- HCR 17: Tracie Bent, Chief Planning and Policy Officer, State Board of Education, spoke about HCR 17, legislation which would reject **Docket No. 08-0204-2201 and 08-0301-2201.** She said the administrative rules governing Public Charter Schools and rules of the Public Charter School Commission are not consistent with legislative intent.
- MOTION: Rep. Price made a motion to send HCR 17 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation. Motion carried by voice vote. Reps. Berch and McCann requested to be recorded as voting NAY. Rep. Hawkins will sponsor the bill on the floor.
- **SCR 107: Tracie Bent** spoke about **SCR 107**, legislation which would reject a portion of **Docket No. 08-0111-2201**. She said this rejection would not allow Western Governors University to be listed as a postsecondary school who is exempt from registering with the State Board of Education.
- MOTION: Rep. Nelsen made a motion to send SCR 107 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation. Motion carried by voice vote. Reps. Garner and McCann requested to be recorded as voting NAY. Rep. Price will sponsor the bill on the floor.
