- School Administrators, SROs, Teachers, Nurses
- 680+ of participants, across the state
- Questions about vaping, smoking, other drugs
- Triangulating with other agencies' data

Idaho Youth Wellbeing Assessment

- Based on Icelandic Prevention Model
- Idaho developed
- Parental opt-in required
- Focus on risk & protective factors
