- RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE; AMENDING SECTION 41-253, IDAHO
 CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT A VIOLATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE SHALL
 BE A MISDEMEANOR AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND DECLARING AN
 EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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7 SECTION 1. That Section 41-253, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 8 amended to read as follows:

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE -- ADOPTION OF INTERNATIONAL FIRE 9 41-253. CODE. (1) The purpose of sections 41-253 this section through section 10 41-269, Idaho Code, is to protect human life from fire, and to prevent fires. 11 12 These sections are intended to prescribe regulations consistent with nationally recognized good practice for the safeguarding of life and property 13 from hazards of fire and explosion arising from the storage, handling and use 14 of hazardous substances, materials, and devices τ and from conditions haz-15 ardous to life or property in the use or occupancy of buildings or premises, 16 and there is hereby adopted the "International Fire Code," 2000 edition, 17 with appendices thereto, published by the International Code Council, Inc. 18 and such later editions as may be so published and adopted by the state fire 19 marshal, as the minimum standards for the protection of life and property 20 from fire and explosions in the state of Idaho. A person who violates a pro-21 22 vision of the International Fire Code as adopted by the state of Idaho shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. 23

(2) A detached single family dwelling τ to be constructed upon on lands 24 of five (5) acres or more outside an incorporated city and not within a 25 designated area of city impact_{τ} shall be exempt from the water supply and 26 access requirements of the adopted version of the International Fire Code 27 unless a county land use or subdivision ordinance requires such compliance. 28 A county-adopted ordinance may expand the foregoing exemption applicable 29 to detached single family dwellings by reducing the minimum parcel area re-30 quirement after first conducting a public hearing subject to public notice 31 that complies with the requirements set forth in section 67-6509, Idaho 32 Code, and after providing notice by mail to all fire agencies providing 33 services to areas outside an incorporated city and not within a designated 34 area of city impact that might be affected by any such proposal at least 35 36 twenty-one (21) days prior to such public hearing.

(3) Assistants to the state fire marshal, as provided in section
41-256, Idaho Code, shall apply a reasonable interpretation to the International Fire Code, as adopted by the state fire marshal, and rules of the state
fire marshal, when undertaking any enforcement action.

(4) For the purposes of sections 41-253 this section through section
41-269, Idaho Code, the "International Fire Code" shall mean the publications as adopted under subsection (1) of this section.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
July 1, 2024.
