2	RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT; AMENDING CHAPTER 23, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE,
3	BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 67-2360, IDAHO CODE, TO PROHIBIT DE-
4	PARTMENTS OF THE STATE FROM DONATING TO OR SPONSORING A NONGOVERNMENTAL
5	EVENT OR ORGANIZATION, TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS, TO PROVIDE THAT ANY DONA-
6	TION OR SPONSORSHIP MADE BY A BOARD OR COMMISSION SHALL BE APPROVED BY
7	THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, TO PROVIDE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS, AND TO
8	PROVIDE A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFEC-
9	TIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 23, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a  $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$ , to be known and designated as Section 67-2360, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 67-2360. DEPARTMENTS OF THE STATE -- DONATIONS AND SPONSORSHIPS PROHIBITED -- REPORTING -- PENALTY. (1) No donation or sponsorship to any non-governmental event or organization shall be made by or in the name of any of the twenty (20) departments of the state government unless the department is required to do so by law or has received prior written permission from the governor.
- (2) Any donation or sponsorship to any nongovernmental event or organization made by any board or commission of state government, including but not limited to those entities within the department of self-governing agencies set forth in section 67-2601, Idaho Code, shall be approved by the chief executive officer of such board or commission.
- (3) Not later than February 1 of each year, the division of financial management shall provide a report that lists all sponsorships and donations made by any department, board, commission, or other entity of state government to the chairs of the joint finance-appropriations committee, the house revenue and taxation committee, and the senate local government and taxation committee.
- (4) Any public officer or public employee who knowingly violates the provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall be in violation of section 18-5701(10), Idaho Code, for misuse of public moneys and shall be subject to punishment pursuant to section 18-5702, Idaho Code.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
