 5, TITLE 61, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 61-502C, IDAHO
 CODE, TO PROVIDE A LIMITATION ON CERTAIN ELECTRIC UTILITY REQUIREMENTS;
 AMENDING CHAPTER 10, TITLE 54, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW
 SECTION 54-1001A, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE A LIMITATION ON CERTAIN IDAHO
 ELECTRICAL CODE REQUIREMENTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 5, Title 61, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des11 ignated as Section 61-502C, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

61-502C. COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS -- MULTIPLE EXISTING METERS. Notwith standing any provision of law to the contrary, a public utility providing
 electric service to a commercial building or to a unit within a commercial
 building shall not require a single electricity meter.

SECTION 2. That Chapter 10, Title 54, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des ignated as Section 54-1001A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

19 54-1001A. ELECTRIC METERS. Notwithstanding any provision of law to 20 the contrary, the Idaho electrical code shall not require a commercial 21 building or a unit within a commercial building to have a single electricity 22 meter.

23 SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 24 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
 25 passage and approval.
