RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

SERVICES; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE OFFICE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED

FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; PROVIDING FOR
ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of Information Technology Services the following amounts to be expended for the designated expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Office of Information Technology Services is authorized no more than two hundred twenty-one (221.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. Funds specifically identified in statute or in an appropriation act as intended for a certain purpose may be used only for that purpose. All funds provided in this act shall be subject to accountability reports and management reviews in accordance with Section 67-702, Idaho Code.

SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
