RELATING TO FISH AND GAME; AMENDING CHAPTER 5, TITLE 36, IDAHO CODE, BY THE
 ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 36-508, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS
 REQUIRING NONRESIDENTS TO PROCURE A LICENSE PRIOR TO COLLECTING, POS SESSING, OR TRANSPORTING CERTAIN ANTLERS OR HORNS IN THE STATE AND TO
 PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EF FECTIVE DATE.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 5, Title 36, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des11 ignated as Section 36-508, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

12 36-508. ANTLERS -- HORNS -- LICENSE. A nonresident collecting, possessing, or transporting antlers or horns shed from deer, elk, moose, or pronghorn in this state shall be required to first procure a license entitling the nonresident to hunt big game as provided in chapter 4, title 36, Idaho Code. No license shall be required for a nonresident under twelve (12) years of age who is accompanied by a nonresident who is licensed in compliance with the provisions of this section or by a resident.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
