- RELATING TO DEPREDATION; AMENDING CHAPTER 11, TITLE 36, IDAHO CODE, BY THE
 ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 36-1121, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE LEGISLATIVE
 INTENT, TO PROVIDE FOR COMPENSATION FOR DEPREDATION OF LIVESTOCK BY
 GRIZZLY BEAR AND WOLVES, TO PROVIDE FOR A FUND AND APPROPRIATION, TO
 PROVIDE A PROCESS FOR COMPENSATION, AND TO DEFINE A TERM; AND DECLARING
 AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 11, Title 36, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
 10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des 11 ignated as Section 36-1121, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

12 36-1121. LIVESTOCK DEPREDATION BY GRIZZLY BEAR AND WOLVES. (1) It is
13 the intent of the legislature to provide compensation to livestock owners
14 that have experienced depredation of livestock by grizzly bear and wolves.

(2) The Idaho state department of agriculture, in consultation with the 15 department of fish and game and the office of species conservation, is autho-16 17 rized to carry out the purposes of this section and has spending authority for compensation pursuant to this section to the extent of legislative ap-18 propriation. The depredation of livestock and prevention fund is hereby es-19 tablished in the state treasury. All expenditures from the fund will be paid 20 according to rules promulgated by the Idaho state department of agriculture. 21 22 Beginning on July 1, 2024, and each July 1 thereafter, the legislature shall appropriate two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$225,000) annually 23 to the fund. One hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) of that amount 24 shall be used annually to compensate validated claims for depredation, and 25 seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) of that amount shall be used an-26 nually for conflict prevention and the provision of information regarding 27 deterrents that have proven effective as determined pursuant to rule as pro-28 mulgated by the Idaho state department of agriculture. All claims shall be 29 made to the office of species conservation on or before December 31 of each 30 year. Validated claims for depredation shall be paid on a pro rata basis in 31 the event moneys in the fund are insufficient to pay all validated claims in 32 full, until such time as moneys in the fund are depleted. Any moneys in the 33 fund after payment of validated claims shall then be paid to those livestock 34 owners with probable claims for depredation on a pro rata basis in the event 35 36 moneys in the fund are insufficient to pay all probable claims in full, until such moneys in the fund are depleted. Any moneys in the fund after probable 37 depredation claims are paid shall be carried over to the next calendar year. 38 Interest accruing on moneys in the fund shall be retained in the fund. Moneys 39 shall be continuously appropriated to the fund, but the fund shall not exceed 40 four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000). 41

(3) Compensation for claims validated or deemed probable shall be based
 on current fair market value as provided by the Idaho state department of
 agriculture. Any other compensation paid to a livestock owner for depreda tion shall be deducted from the fair market value prior to payment.

5 (4) For purposes of this section, "livestock" means cattle, sheep, 6 goat, swine, poultry, bees, llamas, or equine animals used for food or in the 7 production of food, fiber, feed, or other agriculture-based consumer prod-8 ucts, domesticated game, or other nonplant life; such term shall not include 9 aquatic animals.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
