- RELATING TO TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT; AMENDING SECTION 49-1422, IDAHO CODE, TO
 REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR OVERTAKING AND
 PASSING A SCHOOL BUS AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE USE OF CERTAIN MONEYS; AND
 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 49-1422, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 8 amended to read as follows:

49-1422. OVERTAKING AND PASSING SCHOOL BUS. (1) The driver of a vehi-9 cle meeting or overtaking from either direction any school bus stopped on the 10 highway shall stop before reaching the school bus when there is in operation 11 12 on a school bus the visual signals specified in section 49-915, Idaho Code, and the driver of a vehicle shall not proceed until the school bus resumes 13 motion or the visual signals are no longer actuated. Oncoming traffic on a 14 highway of more than three (3) lanes is not required to stop upon meeting a 15 school bus when visual signals are actuated. Any person found quilty of vio-16 lating the provisions of this subsection shall be fined an amount of no less 17 than two hundred dollars (\$200) for a first offense under this subsection; no 18 less than four hundred dollars (\$400) for a second offense under this subsec-19 tion within five (5) years of a prior offense under this subsection; and no 20 less than six hundred dollars (\$600) for a third offense under this subsec-21 22 tion within five (5) years of two (2) prior offenses under this subsection. 23 Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this subsection for the first time shall be guilty of an infraction punishable by a fine of three 24 hundred dollars (\$300). A person convicted of a second offense or any subse-25 quent offense under this subsection within five (5) years shall be quilty of 26 a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of no less than six hundred dollars (\$600) 27 or more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or by imprisonment in the county 28 jail not exceeding six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. The 29 department shall notify any person convicted of a violation of this section 30 of the penalties that may be imposed for a second conviction and any subse-31 quent conviction. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 19-4705, Idaho 32 Code, the fines imposed under this subsection in excess of one hundred dol-33 lars (\$100) shall be paid into the school bus camera fund, which is hereby 34 created in the state treasury. Moneys in the fund may be appropriated only 35 for the purpose of installing cameras on school buses to enforce the traffic 36 law established in this section. If no program is established for the ad-37 ministration of the school bus camera fund by July 1, 2024, then such funds 38 shall be distributed pursuant to section 19-4705, Idaho Code. Moneys in the 39 fund may be appropriated only for the purpose of school bus stop arm soft-40 ware, equipment, and training to enforce the provisions of this section. Ad-41

1 ministration of the school bus camera fund shall be overseen by the state de-2 partment of education.

(2) Every school bus shall be equipped with visual signals meeting the
requirements of section 49-915, Idaho Code, which shall be actuated by the
driver of the school bus whenever, but only whenever, the vehicle is stopped
on the highway for the purpose of receiving or discharging school children.
A school bus driver shall not actuate the special visual signals:

(a) In business districts designated by the department or local authorities;

(b) At intersections or other places where traffic is controlled bytraffic control signals or peace officers; or

(c) In designated school bus loading areas where the bus is entirely offthe roadway.

(3) Every school bus shall bear upon the front and rear plainly visible signs containing the words "SCHOOL BUS" in letters not less than eight
(8) inches in height. When a school bus is being operated upon a highway
for purposes other than the actual transportation of children either to or
from school, all markings thereon indicating "school bus" shall be covered
or concealed.

(4) When any school bus is sold and is no longer to be used for the
transportation of pupils, before it may again be used on the highways of this
state, it shall be painted a color other than national school bus glossy yellow, federal standard 595a, color number 13432, and all school bus markings
shall be obliterated.

25 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 26 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
 27 July 1, 2024.
