- 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 18, Title 42, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des-11 ignated as Section 42-1805A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
 - 42-1805A. ORDERS ESTABLISHING OR REVISING THE BASELINE METHODOLOGY FOR DETERMINING MATERIAL INJURY. The director of the department of water resources shall not issue an order establishing or revising the baseline methodology for determining material injury from December 1 through September 30 of the following year unless authorized by the governor. Preparation of an order establishing or revising the baseline methodology for determining material injury may occur at any time of the year.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
