AN ACT

1 RELATING TO COUNTIES; AMENDING SECTION 31-118, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PRO-
2 VISIONS REGARDING THE BOUNDARIES OF CASSIA COUNTY; AMENDING SECTION
3 31-136, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING THE BOUNDARIES OF
4 MINIDOKA COUNTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
5 DATE.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Section 31-118, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
9 amended to read as follows:

10 31-118. CASSIA COUNTY. Cassia county is described as follows: begin-
11 ning with the intersection of the ~~middle of the~~ center of the main channel
12 of Snake river with the north and south center line of section twenty-eight
13 (28), township ten (10) south, range twenty-one (21) east;

14 Western boundary. Thence south on the said center line of said section
15 twenty-eight (28), to the point of intersection of the north line of the
16 right of way of the Minidoka & Southwestern Railroad Company, which point is
17 one hundred (100) feet distant at right angles from the center of the main
18 track of the line of road of said railroad company as the same is now located;
19 thence in a southwesterly direction along the north line of said railroad
20 right of way to a point where said line intersects the south line of the canal
21 right of way of the Twin Falls Land & Water Company, which point of inter-
22 section is one hundred (100) feet distant at right angles from the center
23 line of the main canal of the said Twin Falls Land & Water Company; thence
24 south to the south line of section thirty-six (36), township ten (10) south,
25 range twenty (20) east; thence west to the southwest corner of said section
26 thirty-six (36); thence south on the section lines to the south line of
27 township eleven (11) south, thence west to the southeast corner of township
28 eleven (11) south, range eighteen (18) east; thence south on the range lines
29 to the south line of the state of Idaho (1907, p. 40);

30 Southern boundary. Thence east along the south boundary line of the
31 state of Idaho to the intersection of the same with the one hundred thir-
32 teenth (113th) meridian west from Greenwich;

33 Eastern boundary. Thence north along the said meridian to the inter-
34 section of the same with the (R.C., section 23i) southern line of township
35 twelve (12) south; thence west upon and along the southern line of said
36 township twelve (12), to the southwest corner of township twelve (12) south,
37 range thirty (30) east; thence north upon the range line between ranges
38 twenty-nine (29) and thirty (30) east, to the southwest corner of township
39 nine (9) south, range thirty (30) east;

40 Northern boundary. Thence west along and upon the south line of town-
41 ship nine (9) south, to the southwest corner of section thirty-four (34),
42 township nine (9) south, range twenty-eight (28) east; thence north upon

1 and along the line between sections thirty-three (33) and thirty-four (34),
 2 township nine (9) south, range twenty-eight (28) east, and an extension
 3 thereof to the point where said line so extended intersects the center of the
 4 main channel of Snake river (1913, ch. 6, section 2, p. 32); thence down
 5 the ~~said river~~ center of the main channel of said river in a southwesterly
 6 direction to the point of beginning (R.C., section 23i).
 7 County seat-- Burley.

8 SECTION 2. That Section 31-136, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
 9 amended to read as follows:

10 31-136. MINIDOKA COUNTY. Minidoka county is described as follows: be-
 11 ginning at the point where the center line of the main channel of the Snake
 12 river is intersected by the west section line of section nineteen (19), town-
 13 ship ten (10) south, range twenty-two (22) east;

14 Western boundary. Thence northerly along the township line to the
 15 northwest corner of township eight (8) south, range twenty-two (22) east;
 16 thence easterly along the township line to the southwest corner of section
 17 thirty-four (34), township seven (7) south, range twenty-three (23) east;
 18 thence north along the section line to the north line of township seven (7)
 19 south, range twenty-three (23) east; thence easterly along the township
 20 line to the southwest corner of section thirty-four (34), township six (6)
 21 south, range twenty-three (23) east; thence northerly along a line which
 22 is three (3) miles west of and generally parallel to the east line of range
 23 twenty-three (23) east, north of the first standard parallel south, to the
 24 north line of township three (3) south, range twenty-three (23) east;

25 Northern boundary. Thence easterly along said township line (1913, ch.
 26 3, section 2, pp. 5, 6) to the intersection of the same with the line be-
 27 tween ranges twenty-five (25) and twenty-six (26) east; thence south along
 28 the said range line (R.C., section 23e), to its intersection with the center
 29 line of the main channel of Snake river; thence southwesterly along said cen-
 30 ter line of the main channel of Snake river, to the point of beginning (1913,
 31 ch. 3, section 2, p. 6).

32 County seat--Rupert.

33 SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 34 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
 35 July 1, 2024.
