STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This appropriation to the Office of the Species Conservation provides enhancements to the FY 2025 maintenance budget that includes 1.00 FTP and funding for a new fiscal staff member; funding to receive grants; and the additional 2% CEC.

FISCAL NOTE

This appropriation provides an additional \$113,000 to the maintenance appropriation provided to the Office of the Species Conservation found in House Bill 459. Table 1 shows enhancements to the budget found in the bill, of which the ongoing increase is \$113,000, and there are no onetime appropriation. Table 2 shows all the adjustments leading to the FY 2025 Total Appropriation. The total budget for the Office of Species Conservation is \$19,891,000
