## AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE MILITARY DIVISION; APPROPRIATING ADDI-2 TIONAL MONEYS TO THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; REDUCING 3 THE APPROPRIATION TO THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; REDUC-4 ING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; APPROPRI-5 ATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; 6 APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE HAZ-7 ARDOUS SUBSTANCE EMERGENCY RESPONSE FUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY 8 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 9

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Military Division the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025:

8 SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Military Division and 9 the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$22,000 from the General 10 Fund to the Hazardous Substance Emergency Response Fund as soon as practica-11 ble for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. Such moneys shall be 12 used to reimburse costs incurred by the Office of Emergency Management Pro-13 gram in the Military Division pursuant to Section 39-7110, Idaho Code.

SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, Sections 4 and 5 of this act shall be in full force and effect on and after passage and approval, and Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
