 OF CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; AUTHORIZING ADDI TIONAL FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; PROVIDING
 EXEMPTIONS FROM OBJECT TRANSFER LIMITATIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMER GENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the full-time equivalent position authorization provided to the Division of Career Technical Education is hereby increased by six (6.00) for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

20 SECTION 3. EXEMPTIONS FROM OBJECT TRANSFER LIMITATIONS. Postsecondary Programs within the Division of Career Technical Education are hereby ex-21 empted from the provisions of Section 67-3511(2), Idaho Code, allowing 22 transfers between budgeted programs and for all moneys appropriated to it 23 for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, for federal Perkins Ca-24 25 reer and Technical Education Funds. Legislative appropriations shall not be transferred from one fund to another fund unless expressly approved by the 26 Legislature. 27

28 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 29 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 30 July 1, 2024.
