
FISCAL NOTE

E-Verify is a free system and costs to implement within state agencies will be in little impact as it will be minimal changes to the hiring process. DMV already maintains a website with information to Idahoans and no additional costs will be required to include the necessary information.

The costs to the state for illegal immigration is estimated to currently be \$405,100,000 due to the added educational, law enforcement, health care, public assistance and general governmental services provided to illegal aliens.

This bill has the potential to save the state \$405,100,000 if illegal immigration was eliminated.
